Students who want to be exempted from the General Exam should

1) meet all following requirements and then 2) meet exemption conditions.

1) Requirements for the General Exam

- ① Must be completed in your 3rd Semester or later within 6 years of admission.
- ② At least 33 credits completed by the end of the 3rd Semester.
- 3 Accumulative average GPA of 3.0 or higher
- ④ Completed all CORE Courses.
- * If you do not meet any of requirements above, you are not eligible for the General Exam and Thesis Submission until you meet all the requirements above.
- * You can take the General Exam from the 4th Semester within 6 years from enrollment.

2) Exemption Conditions for the General Exam

- a. Meet all the Requirements for the General Exam above.
- b. Accumulative average GPA of 3.3 or higher after completion of the 3rd Semester


