- A. For undergraduate and graduate degree candidates on the Seoul / Sejong Campus
  - 1) 2020 degree candidates (graduating Aug 2020 or Feb 2021)
  - 2) 2019 graduates who have not rented gowns (graduating Aug 2019 or Feb 2020)
- \*\* Academic gowns for doctoral degree candidates should be arranged individually. Master's degree candidates
   from Special / Professional graduate schools are advised to contact the administrative office of each graduate
   school for academic gowns.
- B. Limits on the number of gown rental applicants per location
  - 1) Humanities and Social Sciences Campus: 1F Chey Jong-Hyun Hall, SK Future Hall → 300 applicants per day
  - Science Campus: B1 Exhibition Hall, Hana Square → 200 applicants per day
     graduates who have not rented gowns are only permitted to rent gowns at the Chey Jong-Hyun Hall at
     SK Hall, with 500 applicants allowed per day.
- C. Rental Service Period
- 1) 2020 degree candidates: Tuesday, Feb 16, 2021 to Thursday, Feb 25, 2021 <8 weekdays, excluding Sat/Sun>
  - 2) 2019 graduates who have not rented gowns: : Saturday, Feb 20, 2021 to Sunday, Feb 21, 2021 < Weekend (2 days only)>
  - X Return: Tuesday, Feb 16, 2021 to Thursday, Feb 25, 2021 (10:00 AM to 17:00 PM)
  - Academic gown rental service will not be available after Thursday, Feb 25, 2021. Overdue gowns (after Feb 25) can be returned at the night-duty room, Korea University's Main Hall.
  - D. Rental Application Period
- 1) 2020 degree candidates (graduating Aug 2020 or Feb 2021): Tuesday, Feb 9, 2021 (10:00 AM) to Thursday, Feb 25, 2021 (16:00 PM)
  - 2) 2019 graduates who have not rented gowns (graduating Aug 2019 or Feb 2020): Friday, Feb 5, 2021 (10:00 AM) to Monday, Feb 8, 2021 (12:00 noon)
