- -Chinese/Korean citizens.
- -Fudan U SIRPA/Korea U GSIS graduate students who can participate in this short term program without possibility of cancelation once admitted.
- -Applicants need to submit the copy of his/her latest transcript and must have a grade point average (GPA) of more than 3.0 out of 4.00 in total.
- After completing this program at Kobe University, applicant must return to home institution and continue his/her studies with the aim of receiving a degree from his/her home institution.
- -After completing the program, applicant must submit a questionnaire/report that demonstrates the results gained from participating in the program
- -Applicants who are not receiving any other scholarships/subsidies from other organizations as the financial support to participate in this program.

Application Procedure:

- Submit the application sheet (free style) including the following information: name, gender, nationality, email address, student status (master/doctor), major, purpose of the application, and research interest.
- Submit the application to CAMPUS Asia team at Fudan/Korea University **by April** 13th.
- CAMPUS Asia team at Fudan/Korea will collect all applications and send them all together to Kobe CAMPUS Asia team by e-mail.
- Kobe University CAMPUS Asia team will select qualified applicants and announce the result by April 14th.
