The Dual Masters Degree

- Students studying on the International Studies pathways can opt to spend their second year at SOAS to follow two course options: MSc International Business; MSc Public Policy, Finance and Management
- Students will graduate with two masters certificates from Korea and SOAS
- Eligibility to enter SOAS
 - 2 pathways; first semester at Korea (March intake) and transfer to SOAS
 - First year at Korea (September 20 intake) and then transfer to SOAS
 - You need to attain a pass mark and
 - Must have met the English Language requirements – IELTS 6.5 overall with 6.5 in writing and speaking and 6.0 in reading and listening
- Apply as other students through [SOAS Postgraduate application portal](#)
- Fees:
 - Fees at SOAS, £21,880 international fee less 30% discount
