<p><b>Application Period</b></p>	<p><b>Application Deadline</b> The deadline is 30th of June 2022.</p> <p>** Applicants who require a student visa and wish to join SOAS should bear in mind visa applications can take several weeks, so you should apply as soon as possible **</p>
