Program Overview

CAMPUS Asia (Collective Action for Mobility Program of University Students in Asia) is an exchange program that is conducted with the support of the Education Ministry of the Korean, Chinese and Japanese government, which pursues the Asian version of ERASMUS. Since 2012 spring semester, KU GSIS has established a consortium with GSICS of Kobe University and SIRPA of Fudan University. Three universities are running exchange student programs and dual degree programs to train graduate students to become risk management experts in East Asia.
