MA Department of International Studies

MA International Studies (International Commerce)

The goal of this two-year program is to provide students with an enhanced understanding of international commerce within the process of globalization. Relevant courses will equip students with the skills, knowledge and experiences necessary in the fields of trade, finance, business and marketing. A wide range of relevant courses include: Macroeconomics, Strategic Management, Electronic Commerce, Multilateral and Regional Cooperation for Economic Development, Foreign Direct Investment, and Money and Banking.

MA International Studies (International Development and Cooperation)

This two-year program deals with relevant issues in international development. Students will explore various aspects of interactions among states, international organizations, and individuals in reducing poverty and providing sustainable development. The offered courses include Multilateral and Regional Cooperation for Economic Development, International Development Organizations, Water & Development in East Asia, and Sustainable Development & International Development.

MA International Studies (International Peace and Security)

This two-year program provides rigorous and policy-related courses in Global Politics with a special focus on International Peace and Security. A series of courses on international peace and security include: World Politics, International Negotiation, Comparative Foreign Policy, History of International Relations, International Relations in East Asia, Approaches to International Peace, North-South Korea Relations, International Law and Human Rights.

MA International Studies (Area Studies)

This two-year program offers students the opportunity to develop a deep and broad understanding of issues related to a variety of regions. Some exemplary courses include: Contemporary North America, Contemporary East Asia, Contemporary Europe, Understanding East Asian Civilization, East Asian Economies, The U.S. Economy, European Economies, International Relations of North America, International Relations of East Asia, International Relations of Europe/Russia, and Korea-U.S. Relations.

- European Studies

This sub-program offers students with a series of courses to provide them with an in-depth analysis and evaluation of government policies and multi-lateral relations related to European countries. The ways of teaching in the courses vary: lectures; research seminars; simulation exercises; workshops; and meeting with invited specialists. Some related exemplary courses are EU Economy, Trade & Investment in the EU, Politics of the Korea-EU Relations, and Special Topics in Russian Studies.

- East Asian Studies

The sub-program of the East Asian Studies provides a list of courses for students to analyze and assess one of the most dynamic and rapidly developing socio-economic and political systems in the world. Some exemplary courses are East Asian Economy, East Asian Trade & Investment, Environment & Development in China/East Asia, and Korea & APEC.

MA Department of Korean Studies

MA Korean Studies

The Department of Korean Studies at GSIS aims to equip international and domestic students with an enhanced understanding of Korea, including its contemporary social modernization, and economic development. GSIS offers both two-year Master's degree and one-year diploma. Although all the courses in the program are taught in English, a high level of Korean language and reading courses are available in Korean for students who want to have intensive training in the Korean language. Current courses include: Modern History of Korea, Social Movement and Political Change, Social Problems in Korea, Korean Economy, Korean Cinema in the Global Context, and Dynamics of Korean Management.

- 제1조 (목적) 이 세칙은 본교 대학원학칙(이하 "학칙"이라 함) 및 대학원 학사운영규정이 국 제대학원(이하 "대학원"이라 함)에 위임한 사항과 그 시행에 필요한 세부사항을 규정 함을 목적으로 한다.
- 제2조 (교육목표) 이 대학원은 국제관계 및 세계 각 지역에 관한 이론 및 실무를 심도 있게 연구하고 교육하여 한국의 국제화를 능동적으로 주도할 역량을 갖춘 국제전문가 및 지도급 인재를 육성함으로써 국가와 사회발전에 기여하고, 아울러 한국에 관심이 있 는 외국인들에게 한국에 관한 체계적인 연구기회를 제공함으로써 세계 속의 한국의 위상을 더욱 높이는 것을 교육목표로 한다.
- 제3조 (교육과정) 석·박사과정 학생이 이수하여야 할 교과목 및 학점은 따로 내규로 정한다.
- 제4조 (수업연한 및 재학연한) ① 석사학위과정과 박사학위과정의 수업연한은 2년으로 한다. 단, 산·학·연 협동과정 및 학·석사연계과정 등 특별프로그램에 의한 석사과정의 경우 총장의 승인을 얻어 수업연한을 6개월 단축할 수 있다.
 - ② 석사과정 수업연한 단축에 관한 세부사항은 내규에 따로 정한다.
 - ③ 석사과정의 재학연한은 입학일로부터 6년을 초과할 수 없으며, 박사과정의 재학연 한은 입학일로부터 10년을 초과할 수 없다. <개정 2018,09,01,>
 - ④ 재학연한을 경과한 자는 제적 처리하며, 재학연한이 경과된 수료생의 경우 영구수 료로 처리한다. <항신설 2018.09.01.>
- 제5조 (수료를 위한 최소이수학점) ① 학위과정 수료에 필요한 학점은 석사과정 39학점(학 위청구논문작성을 할 경우) 또는 42학점(학위청구논문작성을 하지 않을 경우), 박사과 정 36학점 이상으로 한다. <개정 2018,09,01,>
 - ② 제1항의 수료를 위한 총 이수학점의 평점평균은 3.0 이상이어야 한다.
- 제6조 (학기별 학점취득) 매 학기별 학점취득은 석사과정 15학점, 박사과정 12학점까지 취득 할 수 있다.
- 제7조 (휴학기간) ① 휴학은 1년 또는 학기 단위로 할 수 있으며, 통산 휴학 기간은 3학기로 한다.
 - ② 군복무,출산으로 인한 휴학은 제1항의 휴학기간에 포함하지 아니한다. 단,군복무 기간은 의무복무 기간에 한정한다.
 - ③ 휴학기간은 학위청구논문제출 연한에 산입한다. 단, 대학원위원회에서 휴학 사유가

- 특별하다고 인정한 경우에는 산입하지 아니 할 수 있다.
- ④ 신입생, 재입학생의 경우에도 입학 후 첫 학기부터 휴학을 신청할 수 있다.
- 제8조 (수업) ① 수업은 주간에 실시하며, 필요에 따라 공휴일 수업과 현장실습을 할 수 있 다.
