## Immigration – Student Visa (D–2)

- Students must arrive in Korea with <u>D-2 visa</u> (student visa);
  - Students already in Korea holding a different visa\* must apply for a D-2 visa before the start of the semester (1st September 2020) - URGENT - apply for visa change at Sejongno Immigration Office;
  - \* Students with F, A or E-type visa do not have to change their visa status.
- If you take a semester off, your current visa will be terminated, and when you want to return to school, you will need a new certificate of registration from the university for a new D-2 visa.
- If your visa is terminated, you have 15 days to leave Korea; if you do not leave within that time, you will be fined and deported.

## Immigration – Alien Registration Card (ARC)

- A residence permit for foreigners living in Korea; if you leave the country and your visa status is single entry, you need this card to be able to re-enter Korea;
- Must be obtained within 90 days of entering Korea (takes 2-3 weeks to receive) URGENT;
- Your ARC can be acquired by appointment at <u>Sejongno Immigration Office;</u>
  - Previously, you could go to the immigration office for your area, however now you must go to the <u>Sejongno Branch</u> regardless of your place of residency.
- Must make an <u>online reservation</u> first before visiting the immigration office  $\rightarrow$  <u>hikorea.go.kr</u>
- Please refer to Visa & Immigration Guide PPT sent by Administrative Office for detailed guide, or stop by the Student Council office (#428) for help.
- **DO NOT** leave Korea until before the process is complete and you have <u>received your ARC</u>; otherwise, your ARC application and D-2 visa will be terminated and you will not be permitted to reenter Korea.

## Immigration – Obligation to Report Changes

- You must report certain changes to the Immigration Office promptly within 14 days of occurrence;
  - 1. Any changes to PASSPORT information (e.g. name, sex, nationality, passport number, expiry date);
  - 2. Any changes to ARC information (e.g. residency address);
  - 3. If you lose your ARC (apply for re-issuance).
- Change of address can be reported to an <u>Immigration Office / City Hall / Local Gu Office</u>. Documents needed:
  - 'Confirmation of Residence/Accommodation' (for dormitory and off-campus housing);
  - Dormitory payment receipt (for dormitory);
  - Copy of rental contract (for off-campus housing);
  - Copy of accommodation provider's ID (for off-campus housing).
- If you do not report changes within 14 days, you will be fined.

## KUGSIS Student Essentials – KUPID Portal

- KUPID is a portal that gives you access to a wide range of services related to KU (like Blackboard, course registration, evaluations, connecting to KU wifi, etc.).
- KUPID URL: <u>http://portal.korea.ac.kr</u>
- Creating KUPID ID:
  - Single ID create your own ID that will be used for both KUPID and Blackboard;
  - Type in your student ID (will be told by Administration Office);
  - Password (will be told by Administration Office);
  - <u>Name, surname, and email must be identical</u> to what you used to apply to KU GSIS.
- If you want a KU email address, click yes.
- If not, just use the email address you used when applying for KU GSIS.



  - class forum chats/posts.
- Access Blackboard at <u>kulms.korea.ac.kr</u> with your KUPID ID and password;
- It will only be available a few days after you make your <u>KUPID</u> account!

## KU GSIS Student Essentials – Course Registration

- Course registration (new students): **20th 21st August (5PM)**.
- Add/Drop Period: 7th 9th September (5PM).
- Maximum of <u>15 credits</u> per semester (5 classes).
- Please refer to your <u>orientation material</u> to see which courses are needed to fulfill each requirement. You must keep track of the courses you are taking so that you can graduate on time:

#### • THERE IS NO ONLINE DEGREE AUDIT FUNCTION AT KU GSIS;

• The office may be consulted as you approach graduation.

## KU GSIS Student Essentials – Banking Options

**Bank account**: You can open a bank account at both Hana Bank branches on campus. You just need to bring your <u>passport</u>, your <u>ARC</u> if you have one already, and fill out a form.

 Important! Both Hana Bank branches on the campus will be able to link your debit/transit card to your <u>student card</u>.

## KU GSIS Student Essentials - Health Insurance

- **KU Health Insurance Fee** if you pay the small fee for health insurance from KU each semester (during your tuition payment), you can benefit from the following:
  - Free treatment for <u>minor issues</u> (e.g. cold, fever), with your student ID you can visit the <u>KU</u> <u>Health Center</u> located at the Central Plaza;
  - You are entitled to receive a discount at <u>KU Hospital</u> (however, you MUST first go to the KU Health Center and receive a certificate to show at the hospital) and a concession from KU-appointed pharmacies.
- National Health Insurance Service (NHIS) has been suspended for those holding a D-2 visa, as such from 16th July 2019 to <u>28th February 2021</u>, D-2 visa holders cannot enroll in this plan yet.
- Recommended to register for your private health insurance for your own safety and full coverage.

## KU GSIS Student Essentials – Health Insurance Cont'd

- If you are sick:
  - 1) Go to <u>KU Health Center</u> with your <u>student ID card;</u>
  - 2) KU Health Center will issue you a <u>certificate</u> (SHC card) proving that you are a Korea University student;
  - 3) Go to the <u>KU Hospital</u> with the certificate (usually the International Clinic on the 2nd floor);
  - N.B. You can also set an appointment if you wish either by calling their office or by email; the staff speak English fluently.

## KU GSIS Student Essentials – Part-Time Job

#### **Required documents:**

#### 1. Passport, and ARC

- 2. "Part-time Work of Foreign Student Confirmation Form" with the employer's signature
- 3. Certificate of the Employer's Business Registration
- 4. Standard Employment Contract
- 5. Transcript of previous semester
- 6. Certificate of Enrollment
- 7. Official TOPIK score report (TOPIK 4 and above)

- Graduate students may work up to 30 hours per week, **but permission is needed!**
- Eligibility:
  - D-2 visa holder;
  - <u>Minimum GPA 2.0</u> from previous semester.
- Steps to apply for permission:
  - Prepare the <u>required documents</u> (see table to left);
  - Take documents to <u>Global Services Center (GSC)</u>;
  - Apply for permission from Immigration Office;
  - You can start working once immigration has approved your part-time work - DO NOT start working before you have obtained permission!!

## Miscellaneous – Cellular Service Providers

At the KT-Olleh store near campus, you can bring your passport and purchase either pre-paid options or, when you have your ARC, a cell phone plan.
