Listening to the voices of the younger generation, "Voice of Youth" is a program that supports student research on diverse issues that impact both South Korea and the world.

Asia Society Korea is recruiting for the sixth class of the **Voice of Youth (VOY)** program. This exciting opportunity to expand your research ability will support you by providing research funding, research assistance, networking opportunities, and publication. In addition, you will receive a certificate of completion upon report submission, along with a book containing the works of all participants.

- 1. Research Topics (Topics can be chosen freely within the four main subject areas)
 - Arts & Culture: Research in various areas such as art, music, literature, and culture.
 - **Education**: Research on the education system of developed countries along with policy suggestions.
 - **Policy & Society**: Research on East Asian political issues and domestic social issues.
 - **Business & Economy**: Research on prospects for future industries and economic development.

2. Qualifications

- University students in South Korea.
 - *Applicants who are in the process of completing bachelor's/master's/doctoral courses at a South Korean university, or who are expected to enroll this year.
- Majoring in a relevant field.
- Able to participate in various events during the program.
- An interest in current affairs and social issues.
- Able to research and write in English.

3. Benefits

- Networking opportunities and research assistance will be provided.
- Invitations to attend monthly luncheons and seminars hosted by Asia Society Korea.
- Final research papers will be published in a special volume and a VOY program certificate will be awarded.
- Asia Society Korea's Student Membership will be given to the researcher with the most outstanding performance.
- Maximum of 1,000,000 KRW will be funded towards research.

• May 4, 2023, at 18:00: Deadline for applications.



- May 10-12, 2023: 30-minute interviews
- May 18, 2023: Selection process completed.
- May 2023: Orientation.
- June 2023: Deadline for revised research proposals and budget plan.
- June 2023: Interim check for research projects.
- July 2023: Deadline for final research draft submissions.
- August 2023: Presentations and awards ceremony.
