Welcoming Remarks

We would like to give a hearty welcome to all participants.

Universal Health Coverage(UHC) means that all individuals and communities receive the health services they need without suffering financial hardship. Moving towards UHC requires strengthening health systems in all countries with robust financing strategies.

Over the past decade, many countries including many countries gave accelerated their movement toward UHC through high political commitment and their health-sector reforms, which have oftentimes been triggered by pressing health financing issues and the need to address increasing demands from emergent challenges such as noncommunicable diseases (NCDs), accelerated aging of populations. The rapidly changing contests present opportunities but also challenges, especially in the health financing space where issues such as high out-of-pocket health payments, insufficient budget allocation, fragmented funding flow and population coverage, reduced external funding for essential public health programmes, and passive purchasing practices are often observed, hindering countries' progress towards UHC. The pandemic has put additional pressure on health financing systems in countries, exacerbating all the pre-existing vulnerabilities and further constraining fiscal space for health in the coming years.

In light of these challenges, there is an urgent need for international communities to discuss, share experiences, and build the capacity to develop and implement effective health financing policies that are more equitable, efficient, resilient, and sustainable for the future.

The Republic of Korea has made significant progress towards UHC through the introduction and reforms of national health insurance systems. The role of the social health insurance system is also tested through the pandemic response, with many valuable lessons to share with the rest of the region.

The National Health Insurance Service (NHIS) of the Republic of Korea has 19 years' experience in providing a high-quality capacity building program on social health insurance (SHI), also named NHIS UHC Global Academy (NUGA).

Built from evidence and previous training courses, the 2023 NUGA will be held in support by WHO, bringing country participants, international and Korean experts to take stock of key health financing policy lessons globally and in Korea, and seek reform directions and opportunities for building back better and fairer.
